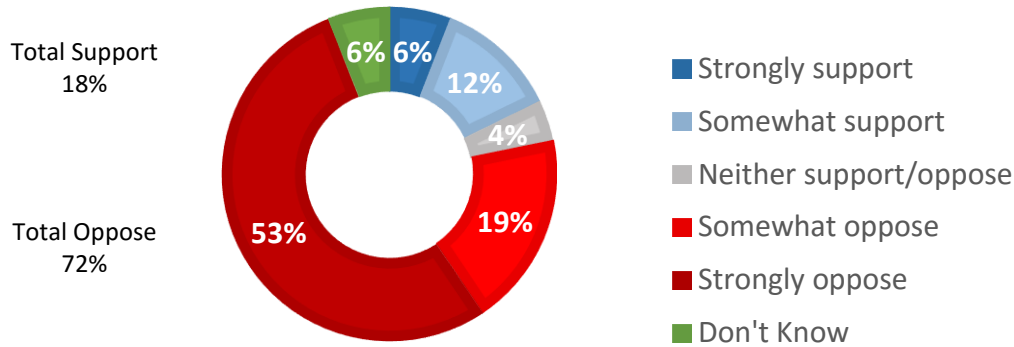


Stop the Michigan Auto Insurance Tax Hike

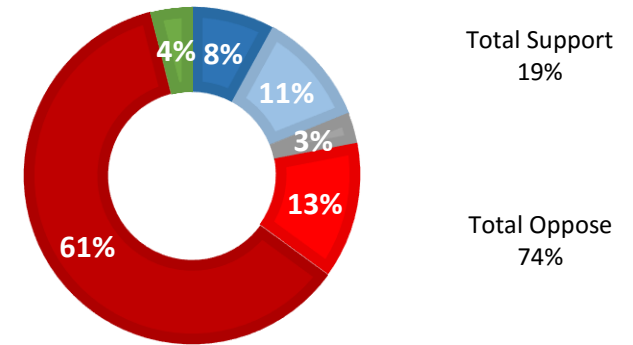

PERCENTAGE SUPPORTING/OPPOSING AUTO INSURANCE TAX HIKE

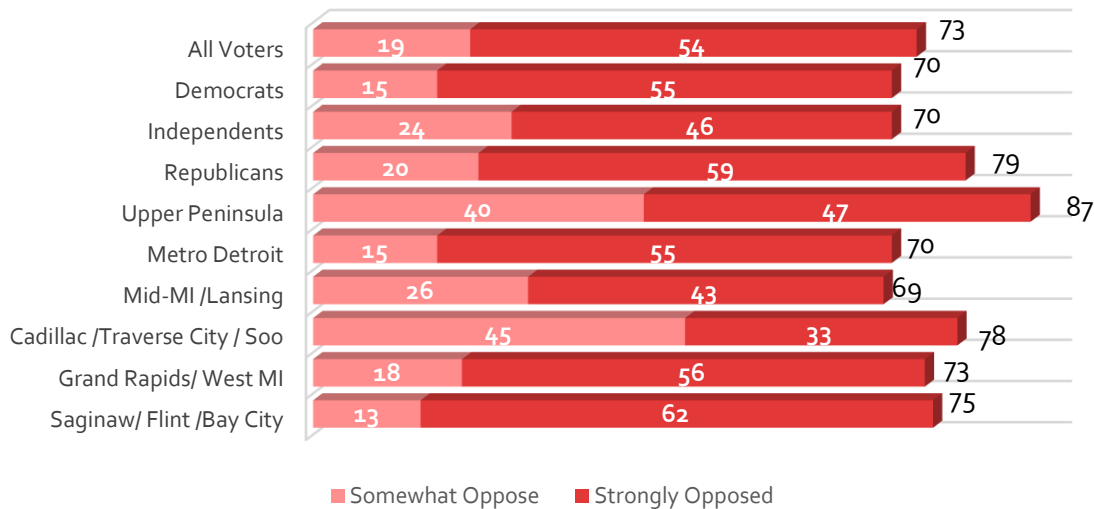
